

Jail Diversion Program Annual Statistics Report

Initial Findings

Of the 35 individuals in the study sample who had been diverted by the JDP:

31/35 had no arrest prior to the JDP intervention [88%]

4/35 people had a prior arrest record [12%]

Out of the 212 total cases examined

109 or 51% involved criminal activity

Of the 109 eligible for arrest, 29 or 26% of the total resulted in an arrest

whereas 74% or 80 people were diverted from arrest

Of those 29 who were arrested

9 of them or 31% were diverted from custody via placement on an inpatient unit,

of the 9, 2 went voluntarily and 7 were involuntary.

The type of charges diverted

Of the 80 people diverted from arrest,

44 involved disturbance/nuisance offenses

25 involved crimes against the person

8 involved property crimes

3 substance abuse crimes
